THESE WATERS SHALL BE HEALED

Ezekiel 47: 9 "And it shall come to pass, that every thing that liveth, which moveth, whithersoever the rivers shall come, shall live: and there shall be a very great multitude of fish, because these waters shall come thither: for they shall be healed: and every thing shall live whither the river cometh."

In the previous chapter of Ezekiel the Lord was showing Ezekiel the measuring of the gateway to the sanctuary, and the inner court, and how the prince was to enter into the sanctuary by the eastern gate, and that gate was to be shut six working days, and opened on the Sabbath, and the new moon. And now in this chapter 47 we begin to see the revelation of a great move of God that is to take place in the latter days.

This Subject is so overwhelming and amazing that I find it difficult to find a starting place. Ezekiel the Prophet, and John the Revelator, each have been given this tremendous task of writing their revelations of God, and in turn finding words to speak so that those of us that follow afterward can understand. Through the ages of time since they prophesied, our language has changed, and words that each of them used, have been replaced with other words that are to mean the same, but are unfamiliar to those of us in this period of time.

With this in mind, I will try to expound on the 47th chapter of Ezekiel, and incorporate into this same revelation, the writings of other prophets that have written on the same thought on the same subject in other books of the Bible.

Ezekiel was one of the first ones that were taken captive by the king of Babylon when they overcame the city of Jerusalem in approximately 608 BC. He was among the captives by the river <u>Ch</u>ebar when the heavens opened and He saw visions of God, Ezekiel 1:1. "It came to pass in the thirtieth year, in the fourth month, in the fifth day of the month, as I was among the captives by the river of Chebar, that the heavens were opened, and I saw visions of God."

God began to show him things through visions, that had never been revealed before, and the Scripture shows that the Word of the Lord came EXPRESSLY to Ezekiel. Throughout the whole book of Ezekiel the Spirit of the Lord lifted him up and took him away Ezekiel 3:14, "So the spirit lifted me up, and took me away, and I went in bitterness, in the heat of my spirit; but the hand of the Lord was strong upon me." And the glory of the Lord upon Ezekiel was so strong that he fell on his face, Ezekiel 1:28.

There is so much that we could write about throughout the rest of this book, but right at this time the scripture that I have quoted above is strong on my mind. We understand that the River that Ezekiel is referring to is the River of Life, the moving of the Holy Spirit of God.

Return to Ezekiel 47:1 "AFTERWARD he brought me again unto the door of the house;

and, behold, waters issued out from under the threshold of the house <u>eastward</u>: for the <u>forefront of the house stood toward the east</u>, and the waters came down from under the <u>right</u> side of the house, at the south side of the altar.

- 2. Then brought he me out of the way of the gate northward, and led me about the way without unto the utter (other) gate by the way that looketh eastward; and behold, there ran out waters on the right side.
- 3. And when the man that had the line in his hand went forth eastward, he measured a thousand cubits, and he brought me through the waters, the waters were to the ankles.
- 4. Again he measured a thousand, and brought me through the waters; the waters were to the knees. Again he measured a thousand, and brought me through; the waters were to the loins.
- 5. <u>Afterward</u> he measured a thousand; and it <u>was a river that I could not pass over:</u> for the waters were risen, waters to <u>swim in</u>, a river that could not be passed over.

What is Ezekiel talking about? In the Bible, waters often refer to people, as well as the Spirit of the Lord. Using the waters as a reference to the Spirit, we can see that the man that had a measuring line in his hand measured a thousand cubits, and the waters were to the ankles:
(Typical of the first dispensation of 2,000 years, of the Father): When he measured the next thousand, the waters were to the knees:
(Typical of the 2,000 years Central dispensation of the Son, Jesus): when he measured again the waters were to the loins:
(Typical of the 2,000 year dispensation of the Holy Spirit): then he measured the fourth time and there was a river that could not be passed over; waters to swim in
(Typical of the White Horse and His Rider, Jesus and His Church:) The Holy Spirit as the White Horse, and the Rider, Jesus and His Church.

The first 2 Chapters of Joel should be quoted, but space and time is consuming, so therefore I exhort each of you to read all 3 chapters of the book of Joel. It all has to do with the last days of time and the coming of the Lord, in His great move for the salvation of souls, when Hebrews says that, Jesus was "once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation."

Jesus came the first time and gave his life on the Cross at Calvary to bear our sins, and NOW Paul says that to those that look for Him shall <u>He APPEAR the SECOND TIME</u> WITHOUT SIN, unto SALVATION. He is not coming to redo His mission on the Cross of Calvary, nor is He coming to catch His Bride away, nor to raise the righteous dead, but He IS appearing to lead His Great Army in a great move for the salvation of souls.

This is the ONLY place in the Bible that the ministry mentions as the SECOND COMING. It does not say SECOND COMING, it does say that He will appear the second time to those that look for Him, without sin unto salvation: not to raise the righteous dead or to catch away the righteous that remain.

Joel 2:1 "Blow the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in my holy mountain: let all the inhabitants of the land tremble: for the day of the Lord cometh, for it is nigh at hand;

- 2. <u>A day of darkness and of gloominess</u>, a <u>day of clouds and of thick darkness</u>, as the morning spread upon the mountains: a great people and a strong; there hath not been ever the like, neither shall be any more after it, even to the years of many generations.
- 3. A fire devoureth before them; and behind them a flame burneth: the land is as the <u>garden of Eden before them</u>, and <u>behind them</u> a desolate wilderness; yea, and nothing shall escape them.

- 4. The appearance of them is as the appearance of horses; and as horsemen, so shall they run.
- 5. Like the noise of chariots on the tops of mountains shall they leap, like the noise of a flame of fire that devoureth the stubble, as a strong people set in battle array.
- 6. Before their face the people shall be much pained: all faces shall gather blackness.
- 7. They shall run like mighty men; they shall climb the wall like men of war; and they shall march every on eon his ways, and they shall not break their ranks:
- 8. Neither shall one thrust another; they shall walk every one in his path: and when they fall upon the sword, they shall not be wounded. (In Daniel 3:27, the fire had no power on him.)
- 9. They shall run to and fro in the city; they shall run upon the wall, they shall climb up upon the houses; they shall enter in at the windows like a thief. (He will come as a thief in the night, 1^{st} Thessalonians 5:2, Matthew 24:33.)
- 10. The <u>earth shall quake before them;</u> the heavens shall tremble: the <u>sun and the moon shall</u> <u>be dark, and the stars shall withdraw their shining:</u>
- 11. And the Lord shall utter his voice before his army: for his camp is very great: for he is strong that executeth his word: for the day of the Lord is great and very terrible; and WHO CAN ABIDE IT?

Joel 3: 18. "And it shall come to pass in that day, that the mountains shall drop down new wine, and a fountain shall come forth of the house of the Lord, and shall water the valley of Shit-tim. (Shittim: Abel-Shittim: Shittim was the <u>last stop of Israel</u> in their wilderness journey, <u>before they crossed the Jordan into Canaan's land</u>, and Shittim is referred to as "meadows of acacias") There Balaam tried to curse Israel but he had to bless them instead. Numbers 25:1, 33:49.) This is the last stop of the Church before they are caught up to meet the Lord in the air, 1st Thessalonians 4:13-17.

Shittim was the last stop of Israel before they crossed the Jordan into the land of Canaan, and this move by the White Horse and His Rider (the moving of the Holy Spirit, and Jesus and His Church,) is the last move of God for the salvation of souls, and this move will end this dispensation of time

Joel 3:18 "And it shall cone to pass in that day, that the mountains shall drop down new wine, and the hills shall flow with milk, and all the rivers of Judah shall flow with waters,

Zechariah 14:8 "And it shall be <u>in that day</u>, that <u>living waters</u> shall go out from Jerusalem; half of them toward the former sea, (eastern) and half of them toward the hinder sea: in summer and in winter shall it be."

LIVING WATERS WILL BE FLOWING LIKE WINE!

John 4: 11 "Jesus answered and said, If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of him, and he would have given thee <u>living water."</u>

What an exciting time to be ONE in that ARMY of the Lord when Jesus comes with all of His power and glory along with His People, the Church of Jesus Christ. This is at the same time that the Antichrist is having power over all the earth, except for the land of <u>GOSHEN</u>, which will be as the land of Israel and the land that was <u>Mesopotamia</u>. A great revival will come at the SECOND APPEARING OF JESUS.

Return to Ezekiel 47 verse 6. And he said unto me, Son of man, hast thou seen this? Then he brought me, and caused me to return to the brink of the river.

- 7. Now when I had returned, behold, at the bank of the river were very <u>many trees</u> on the one side and on the other.
- 8. Then said he unto me, These waters issue out toward the east country, and go down into the desert, and go into the sea: which being brought forth into sea, the waters shall be healed." (Elisha healed the waters, 2nd Kings 2:21-22.)
- 9. And it shall come to pass, that every thing that liveth, which moveth, whithersoever the rivers shall come, shall live: and there shall be a very great multitude of fish, because these waters shall come thither; for they shall be healed; and every thing shall live whiter the river cometh." (Everything shall live where The Holy Spirit comes or flows.)
- 10. And it shall come to pass, that the fishers shall stand upon it from En ge di (a spring or fountain, an oasis on the West coast of the Dead Sea:) (En eg la im; a place by the Dead Sea where Ezekiel prophesied that fishers would one day spread their nets, Site unknown) There the fishers will find a place to spread nets; their fish shall be according to their kinds, and the fish of the great sea, exceedingly many.)
- 11. But the miry places thereof and the marshes thereof shall not be healed; they shall be given to salt. (God will give everyone a chance for salvation but if they don't accept then the marshes will not be healed.)
- 12. And by the river upon the bank thereof, on this side and on that side, shall grow all trees for meat, whose leaf shall not fade, neither shall the fruit there be consumed: it shall bring forth *new fruit* according to his months, because their waters they issued out of the sanctuary: and the fruit thereof shall be for meat, and the leaf thereof for medicine.

When Ezekiel returned to the brink of the river there were many trees on the each side of the river. In the Scripture trees are typical of persons, so when Ezekiel wrote that there were trees on the sides of the river, we then can equate them with reference to trees that were on each side of the river of life in heaven, Revelation 22:1-2 "And he shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb.

2. In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the <u>leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations."</u>

It is made clear that these trees have an important purpose. They are for the healing of the nations, and they are to bring forth <u>new fruit</u>: New Fruit for the Spiritual Man that has reached His place in heaven.

This move of God through the perfected Church of Jesus Christ is a ministry for the salvation of souls, and it is a special event to reclaim those of the Jews that have denied that Jesus is the One that was sent for the salvation of their souls.

Paul Wrote of this TRUTH IN Acts 15: 14 "Simeon hath declared how God at the first did visit the Gentiles, to take out of them a people for his name.

- 15. And to this agree the words of the prophets; as it is written,
- 16. After this, AFTER WHAT? After the Jews were cut off, Romans chapters 9,10,11, and after God has visited the Gentiles and has taken out of them, a People for His name) I will

return, and will build again the tabernacle of David, which is fallen down; and I will build again the ruins thereof, and I will set it up:

17. That the residue of men might seek after the Lord, and all the Gentiles, upon whom my name is called, saith the Lord, who doeth all these things."

This is the time, in this great move of God with His great Army, that He will repair the house of David that is fallen down, Amos 9:11 "In that day will I raise up the tabernacle of David that is fallen, and close up the breaches thereof; and I will raise up his ruins, and I will build it as in the days of old:

- 12. That they may possess the remnant of Edom, and of <u>all the heathen</u>, which are called by my name, saith the Lord that doeth this. (Edom: The descendents of Esau also called Seir and mount Seir; they inhabited an area around the Dead Sea.)
- 13. Behold the days come, saith the Lord, that the plowman shall overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him that soweth seed; and the mountains shall drop sweet wine, and all the hills shall melt.
- 14. And I will bring again the captivity of my people of Israel, and they shall build the waste cities, and inhabit them; and they shall plant vineyards, and drink the wine thereof; they shall also make gardens, and eat the fruit of them.
- 15. And I will plant them upon their land, and they shall no more be pulled up out of their land which I have given them, saith the Lord thy God."

If we recognize that truly this is God speaking of the house of David, and of their coming to realize and accept that their salvation is through Jesus their Savior, then we can begin to align some of the other Scriptures with this truth. In Zechariah 12 we read that God will make Jerusalem a cup of trembling to ALL people round about. He says that He will make the governors of Judah like a fire among the wood and like a torch of fire.

In verse 7, God says that He will save the tents of Judah FIRST, so that the rest of the house of David and of the other people in the land, don't make themselves better or more loved than Judah.

- 9. "And it shall come to pass in that day, that I will seek to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem.
- 10 And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplication: and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him as one mourneth for his only son: and shall be in bitterness for him as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn.
- 11. In that day shall there be a great mourning in Jerusalem, as the mourning of Ha dad rim mon in the valley of Megiddon."

Zechariah 13:1-9 and I quote. "In <u>that day</u> there shall be a <u>fountain opened to the house of David, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, for sin and for uncleanness."</u>

- 2. And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the Lord of hosts, that I will cut off the names of the idols out of the land, and they shall no more be remembered: and also I will cause the prophets and the unclean spirit to pass out of the land.
- 3. And it shall come to pass, that when any shall yet prophesy, then his father and his mother that begat him shall say unto him, <u>Thou shalt not live</u>; for thou speakest lies in the name of the Lord: and his father and his mother that begat him shall thrust him through when he

prophesieth.

- 4. And it shall come to pass in that day, that the prophets shall be ashamed every one of his vision, when he hath prophesied; neither shall they wear a rough garment to deceive:
- 5. But he shall say, I am no prophet, I am an husbandman; for <u>man</u> taught me to keep cattle from my youth.
- 6. And one shall say unto him, What are these wounds in thine hands? Then he shall answer, Those with which I was wounded in the house of my friends.
- (Jesus makes it clear that He came to His Own and His own received Him not. But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name: Which were born not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man but of God. John 1: 11-12
- 7. Awake, O sword, against my shepherd, and against the man that is my fellow, saith the Lord of hosts: smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered: and I will turn mine hand upon the little ones. God is speaking of his sheep (Judah) when they were cut off that the Gentiles should be grafted in Romans 11:17-20

Once again God makes it clear by the prophet Zechariah, that His chosen Shepherd, the Branch, will be smitten and the sheep will be scattered, (Who is Zechariah speaking of when He says that the sheep will be scattered? the house of David) and then He God, will turn His hand against His little Ones (the house of David because they refused to accept His Son Jesus) 8. And it shall come to pass, that in all the land, saith the Lord, two parts therein shall be cut off and die; but the third shall be left therein.

9. And <u>I will bring the third part through the fire</u>, and will refine them as sliver is refined, and will try them as gold is tried: they shall call on my name, and I will hear them: I will say, It is my people: and they shall say, The Lord is my God."

I don't know the percentage of the Jews that God will bring through the fire as this great wave of salvation goes through the land of Jerusalem and Mesopotamia, but the Lord knows who they are. We know that if they accept Jesus and come through the blood that Jesus shed on the Cross of Calvary, they will be saved. But in this period of time, they can never be a part of the 100 fold.

In the 11th Chapter of Isaiah, Isaiah makes it clear that Jesus is the Branch, the Rod that comes out of the stem of Jesse, and He shall grow out of his roots:

- 2. And the Spirit of the Lord will rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom, and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord. Then later in the $10^{\rm th}$ verse, Isaiah says "And in that day there shall be a root of Jesse, (Jesus), which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and his rest shall be glorious.
- 11. <u>And it shall come to pass in that day</u>, that the Lord shall set his hand again the <u>SECOND</u> TIME to recover the <u>REMNANT</u> of his people, which shall be left, from Assyria, and from Egypt, and from Pathros, and from Cush, and from Elam, and from Shinar, and from Hamath, and from the islands of the sea.
- 12. And he shall set up an ensign for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of JUDAH from the four corners of the earth.
- 13. The <u>envy also of Ephraim shall depart</u>, and the <u>adversaries of Judah shall be cut off.</u> Ephraim shall not envy Judah, and Judah shall not vex Ephraim.

- 14. But <u>they</u> shall fly upon the shoulders of the Philistines to ward the west; they shall spoil them of the east together: they <u>shall lay their hand upon Edom and Moab</u>; and the children of Ammon shall obey them.
- 15. And the Lord shall utterly destroy the tongue of the Egyptian sea; and with his mighty wind shall he shake his hand over the river, and shall smite it in the seven streams, and make men go over dryshod. (God knows how to take the people over on dry ground!)
- 16. And there shall be an highway <u>for the REMNANT of his people</u>, which shall be left, from Assyria; like as it was to Israel in the day that he come up out of the land of Egypt.

THE HOUSE UPON THE MOUNT (The TEMPLE of the Living God)

"It shall come to pass in the last days, that the mountain of the LORD'S house shall be established in the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills: and all nations shall flow UNTO it."

3. And many people shall go and say, Come ye, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem." Micah 4: 1-2. Through the ministry of Jesus and His Church the true WORD of God will go forth as never before under the anointing of the Holy Ghost.

Begin reading from verse 3 "And he shall judge among many people, and <u>rebuke strong</u> <u>nations afar off;</u> and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up a sword against nation, neither shall they learn war anymore.

- 4. But they shall sit every man under his vine and under his fig tree; and none shall make them afraid: for the mouth of the Lord of hosts hath spoken it.
- 5. For all people will walk every one in the name of his god, and we will walk in the name of the Lord our God forever and ever.
- 6 In that day, saith the Lord, will I assemble her that halteth, and I will gather her that is driven out, and her that I have afflicted;
- 7. And I will make her that halted a *remnant*, and her that was cast far off a strong nation: and the Lord shall reign over them in mount Zion from henceforth, even for ever.
- 8. And thou, O tower of the flock, the strong hold of <u>the daughter of Zion</u>, unto thee shall it come, even the first dominion; the kingdom shall come to the <u>daughter of Jerusalem</u>.
- 9. Now why dost thou cry out aloud? Is there no king in thee? Is thy counsellor perished? For pangs have taken thee as a woman in travail.
- 10. <u>Be in pain</u>, and <u>labor to bring forth</u>, O daughter of Zion, like a woman in travail: for now shalt thou go forth out of the city, and thou shalt go even to <u>Babylon</u>; there shalt <u>thou be delivered</u>; there the Lord shall redeem thee from the hand of thine enemies.
- 11. Now also many nations are gathered against thee, that say, LET HER BE DEFILED, and let OUR EYE, look upon Zion. "

Continue to read through the end of the chapter!

Micah 4:1-3 725 AD

Verse 6. In that day saith the Lord, will I assemble her that halteth, and I will gather her that is driven out, and her that I have afflicted;

- 7. And I will make her that halted a <u>remnant</u>, and her that was cast far off a strong nation: and the Lord shall reign over them in mount Zion from henceforth, even for ever.
- 626 AD Zephaniah 3:19 "Behold, at that time I will undo all that afflict thee; and <u>I will save her that halteth</u>, and gather her that was driven out; and I will get them praise and fame in every and where they have been put to shame.
- 20 At that time will I bring you again, even in the time that I gather you; for I will make you a name and a praise among all people of the earth, when I turn back your captivity before your eyes, saith the Lord.

Those that cannot understand the moving of the Spirit of God, will be appalled at this woman, 144,000 of them who gives birth to 144,000 babies. They will be completely taken aback by these things and they will not understand. Paul writes in 2nd Thessalonians 2:3 "Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition,

- 4 Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, shewing himself that HE IS GOD.
- 5. Remember ye not, that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things?
- 6. And now ye know what withholdeth that he might be revealed in his time.
- 7. For the MYSTERY of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, UNTIL he be taken out of the way."

The mystery of iniquity certainly will be working for according to Revelation 12 the Devil goes after the Manchild that is born to the Woman and when He cannot destroy the Child, He turns to the Woman with all of His wrath.

Revelation 12: 1-17, READ the whole Chapter

Where do we get this number, 144,000? Revelation 14. 1-"And I looked, and lo, a Lamb stood on mount Sion, and with him an hundred forty and four thousand, having his Father's name written in their foreheads. (The name that is written in their foreheads is not the name of God the Father, but rather it is the name of Jesus who has produced a Child through the perfected Church, the 100 fold. This group of 144,000 is already perfect for they are the product of Jesus who is perfect, and His Church who has become perfect through Her dying out to all sin while She is still here on this earth, and they become the first fruits of God the Father and Jesus the Son of God.)

- 2. And I heard a voice from heaven, as the voice of a great thunder: and I heard the voice of harpers harping with their harps:
- 3. And they sung as it were a <u>new song</u> before the throne, and before the four beasts, and the elders: and <u>no man could learn that song</u> but the hundred and forty and four thousand, which were <u>redeemed</u> from the earth.
- 4. These ARE THEY, WHICH WERE NOT DEFILED WITH WOMEN; for they are virgins. These are they, which follow the Lamb whithsoever he goeth. These were redeemed from among men, being the firstfruits unto God and to the Lamb.
- 5. And in their mouth was found no guile: for they are without fault before the throne of God."

Of course no one else could learn that song, for it was a song of redemption from the sin and corruption of this world, which they had never been a partaker of. In their mouth was found

no guile for they had never been subjected to sin because they were born of Jesus who was perfect and the Woman who had obtained perfection through dying out to all sin while She was still here on this earth, 1st Timothy 5:24-25.

2nd Corinthians 13:1 "In the mouth of two or three witness shall every word be established."

- 1. Moses was hidden in the bulrushes so that Pharaoh could not kill him, Exodus 1:16
- 2. Jesus was hid in Egypt so that Herod could not kill him,
- 3. The Man child was caught away from the presence of the Devil to the throne of God so that he wouldn't be killed.

Moses was born of flesh and blood. Jesus was overshadowed by the Highest. He had been flesh but His Father was Spirit.

Simeon prophesied to Mary, Jesus' mother, "Behold, this child is set for the fall and rising again of many in Israel; and for a sign which shall be spoken against."

The Child of Jesus and the Church, will be flesh from the Woman's side and Spirit from Jesus' side for He had been changed into the Spiritual Realm

Romans 12:19, Deuteronomy 32:35 Hebrews 10:30

ESAU, was the firstborn son of Jacob. Through the years of time, God has had a problem with the tribe of Esau, the son of Jacob. In Micah God relates that the Daughter of Jerusalem will deliver her child in Babylon. I believe that God is taking vengeance on the Muslims, because of their continual rejection of Him. Kind of throwing their rejection back in their face. EDOM: the descendents of Esau also called SEIR The Edomites were subject to Babylon.

Edom: The descendents of Esau also called Seir or Mount Seir. ALSO Idumea

Under the Persian Empire Edom became a province called IDUMEA.

Jacob have I loved and Esau have I hated Romans 9:13 Genesis 25: Esau sold his birthright to Jacob. Isaac loved Esau, Rebekah loved Jacob. Jacob have I loved, Esau have I hated, Romans 9:13 Mal 1:2 Jeremiah 49:10 Against Esau,

Ezek 35:2-15 Seir and Idumea Psalms 137:7-9 Jer 49:7 Verse 13 Bozrah through 22
